

Wood Chipping Opportunities

The 2020 burn pit season has come to a close, but that doesn't mean that the community's fire mitigation efforts have to end! The Indian Mountain Property Owners Association (IMPOA) is initiating a wood chipping pilot program as a free service to IM property owners. Unlike previous chipping days scheduled through CUSP, this chipping program will not require you to pay for the chipping services, nor will you have to provide the labor to feed the chipper. You don't even need to be present to get your chipping done. Property owners will collect slash and stack it on the edge of their property adjacent to the county road, according to specific guidelines in the attached link. Chipping will take place during August and September. This service is being provided by IMPOA on a first-come, first-served basis. Registrations will be accepted until it is estimated that the budget has been exhausted. Results of this pilot program will be used to determine the full breadth and depth of future IMPOA-supported chipping programs.
