

INDIAN MOUNTAIN BURN PIT AGREEMENT

(To be completed by the person who will be dumping)

THE BURN PIT IS TO BE USED ONLY FOR FOREST SLASH (TREES AND BRANCHES) NOTHING ELSE

Please stack the slash high and tight into vertical teepee shaped piles. This allows for an efficient and complete burn.

Prohibited: Large stumps and root balls (if one person can't carry it, it is too big), large green wood, sawdust, wood chips, pine needles from the ground, weeds/grass/sod, dirt, rocks, lumber, construction waste, treated wood like railroad ties, household waste, furniture, tires, auto parts, appliances, propane tanks, hazardous materials, or anything else containing metal (spikes, nails, screws, wire, etc.).

The use of a chainsaw in the pit is expressly prohibited.

Please show your permit to the volunteers at the burn pit. They will inspect your load and tell you where and how to dump it. Volunteers have ultimate authority for Burn Pit Rules.

ANYONE NOT FOLLOWING BURN PIT RULES OR THE DIRECTION OF THE VOLUNTEERS WILL HAVE THEIR PERMIT REVOKED AND THEY WILL BE BANNED FROM THE BURN PIT. We are allowed to use our Burn Pit because we follow the rules of Park County, Jefferson Como Fire Protection District, and the State of Colorado.
